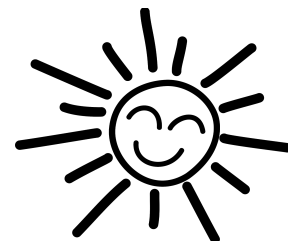

Teen Summer Program

The TSP is open to 14 campers between the ages of 13-18. Teens will be part of camp program in the morning as leaders and helpers to the counselors. All teens will have the opportunity to become Junior Counselors. The afternoon, the teens will have their own program and activities. Tuesday is field trip day just for teens. More detailed Information will be coming in April.

What Parents can expect?

Each week, Parents & Guardians will receive a weekly Schedule & News email about camp and drop in. The campers will be divided into teams by age groups. Campers will spend time daily with their team and camp counselor, as well as participating in all camp games & activities. Activities include art projects, active games, speciality programs, academic hours, and team building games.

Parents can expect a max of 1:10 staff-to-member ratio during camp hours. Staff are trained in areas such as safety and risk management, behavior management and conflict resolution.

All Children must bring close-toed shoes. This is required for playing active games and highly encouraged on the playground.

All Children MUST BRING LUNCH. A snack will be provided every day of camp in the afternoon.



Drop In Academic Hours

Everyday from 1pm - 3pm will be educational program time. We will focus on a variety of subjects throughout the week by integrating education into active games, art activities, and experiments. Members will also get to have supervised chromebook time during these hours.

Field Trip Days

Field Trips are still being determined. Typically, we try to schedule these trips on Wednesday but are subject to change depending on the availability of our field trip location. The field trips go along with the theme of the week. Some field trips will require sign up, others will be included in signing up for camp that week (trips will be clearly labeled as which). Information about field trips and the weeks activities will be sent out in the weekly Schedule & News email. A few Drop In field trips will be offered & will be given plenty of notice for sign up.

Library Days

Thursdays are the designated Ellettsville Library Trip day. We will do a morning Camp Members Trip from 10am - 11:30am. In the afternoon we will do a Drop In Members Trip from 1pm - 2:30pm.

Parents will need to sign up their members for appropriate Library trip when it is posted on Monday on the membership board.

Members who do not sign up for the Library, will still have activities and programs planned for them at the club.

Pool Days

Tuesdays & Fridays are the designated pool days. This summer we will be offering for drop in to join us to go to the pool. Members are not required to go as they have in years past and must be signed up to go on the pool trip.

Parents will need to sign up their members when it is posted on Monday each week, on the membership board.

This summer we will be returning to McCormick's Creek Pool weekly, and Bryan Park Pool on occasion. For pool trips, we will leave the Club at 1pm and return at 4:30pm. Members must supply their own towels and sunscreen.

Members who do not sign up for the pool, will still have activities and programs planned for them at the club.
