**BOYS & GIRLS CLUBS OF BLOOMINGTON EARNS COVETED 4-STAR
RATING FROM CHARITY NAVIGATOR**

Bloomington, Ind. – Due to their strong financial health and commitment to accountability and transparency, the Boys & Girls Clubs of Bloomington has earned a 4-Star Rating from Charity Navigator, America’s largest independent charity evaluator. This is the second time since 2017 that the Club has earned this top distinction.

“It is important our donors trust that we are using their donations wisely to accomplish our mission,” said Jeff Baldwin, Executive Director of the Boys & Girls Clubs of Bloomington. “Our 4-Star Charity Navigator Rating demonstrates our good governance and financial accountability to the community.”

Since 2002, using objective analysis, Charity Navigator has awarded only the most fiscally responsible organizations a 4-Star Rating. In 2011, Charity Navigator added 17 metrics, focused on governance and ethical practices as well as measures of openness, to its ratings methodology. These Accountability & Transparency metrics, which account for 50 percent of a charity’s overall rating, reveal which charities operate in accordance with industry best practices and whether they are open with their donors and stakeholders. On June 1, 2016, the methodology for rating each charity’s financial health was upgraded with CN 2.1. These enhancements further substantiates the financial health of four star charities.

“Boys & Girls Clubs of Bloomington’s exceptional 4-Star Rating sets it apart from its peers and demonstrates its trustworthiness to the public,” according to Michael Thatcher, President & CEO of Charity Navigator. “Only as quarter of charities rated by Charity Navigator receive the distinction of our 4-Star Rating. This adds Boys & Girls Clubs of Bloomington to a preeminent group of charities working to overcome our world’s most pressing challenges. Based on its 4-Star Rating, people can trust that their donations are going to a fiscally responsible and ethical charity when they decide to support the Boys & Girls Clubs of Bloomington.”
