

# Boys & Girls Club of Ellettsville

## Frequently Asked Questions

### **What are your hours?**

We are open every day afterschool from 3 - 6 p.m. during the months of August, December and May. We open from 3 - 7 p.m. for all other school months. During summer, we are open from 7:30 AM to 12 PM for registered campers and from 12-6 PM for all members for Drop-In. We do have scheduled close dates, listed in our Club Calendar.

### **How does parent pick-up work at the Club?**

Parent pick-up will happen at the north facing doors of the Club, located at 8045 W State Rd 46, Ellettsville, IN 47429. We ask you to come in to pick up your child, and bring a photo ID with you. We will not release your child to anyone not on the pick-up list, and we verify ID to make sure.

### **If my child attends a different school, how do they get to the Club?**

This varies by school. As long as the school is listed below, there is a way for them to arrive at the Club without a specific drop-off from a parent.

#### *Richland Bean Blossom Community School Corporation*

The school system provides a bus for transportation to our Club. Members will arrive at the Club between 2:30pm and 4:00 pm., depending on their dismissal and bus departures.

#### *Seven Oaks Classical School*

We take our mini bus to pick up from Seven Oaks. They will be picked up after school and arrive at the Club by 4:00pm. We typically take two routes, one for K-5 at 3:15 p.m. and one at 3:45 p.m. for junior high and high school students.

### **Can I drop my child off at the Club, or do they have to attend directly from school?**

You are welcome to drop your child off at the Club any time, as long we are open and they are picked up by 6:00 or 7 p.m. (depending on our close time). This is especially common during break camps, but you are welcome to drop them off during a school day as well. This is also how members who are either home-schooled or attend school in another district might participate in Club activities.

### **What is the Club's policy for weather cancellation?**

For all breaks and closures, we go with the Richland Bean Blossom schools. The days we consider break camps or day camps will align with that school system, and our Club closure will as well.

This means that if RBB closes due to weather, we will close. If RBB stays open, we will stay open. If school shuts down due to weather in the middle of the day, we will be closed.

### **Is the Club open on days the school is not open? How does that work?**

Most days when school is closed, we are open. Occasionally we will have staff trainings and may be closed. You should know well in advance if we are offering a camp day for a given day or week. Camp runs from 7:30 a.m. to 6 p.m. and costs \$75 per week. On all days we offer camp, we also offer drop-in time from 12 - 6 p.m., and it is free to all members.

For camps, you will sign up your child ahead of time. For drop-in, there is no need to sign up.

### **How often does the Club close? Will I know ahead of time if the Club will be closed?**

It is our goal to stay open as much as possible for our members. We will have occasional closures for staff training. We are always closed for major holidays, such as Christmas Eve and Christmas Day, though we offer break camps during most school breaks on non-holiday days. We will release the days we're open or closed ahead of time in these circumstances. School-year calendars are released in July before the start of school.

We also have two major shutdowns during the year, both for staff on-boarding and Club cleaning. The first is typically the final week of May, and the second is the first week of school..
