

2021 Summer Teen Programming

We are excited to be offering our Junior Leaders Program & CIT Internship again this summer. Please note these programs are not intended for all teens and some may not be developmentally ready to fulfill the requirements of the program. A teen member who is not involved with these programs will be added to our oldest Pod group, and will follow the payment structure of the K-5 program. These grades are based on the 2020-2021 school year.

Junior Leader (Open to members in 6-8th grade)

The Junior Leader program provides middle school members with age-appropriate skill-building opportunities and hands-on Club work experience. They will work alongside Club-staff providing positive youth development in our K-5 programming. Along with this experience, Junior Leaders will participate in professional development and training to build their skills in the youth development field.

- Must be energetic and motivated to work with young children
- Must be committed to 1 day of mandatory pre- training
- Must to commit to at least 5 weeks of participation in the Junior Leaders Program

COST: \$50 per week. Once a member reaches 100 hours of service and has attended at least 4 weeks, they will not be charged a camp fee.

Coordinator-In-Training (C.I.T.) Internship (Open to high school members, 14 years old & up)

A C.I.T. Internship provides our high school members, ages 14 and up, an opportunity to prepare for positions as program coordinators at the Club. Emphasis is placed upon developing leadership skills, sensitivity to children, and program skills. The internship comes with a \$250 stipend awarded upon completion of 75 hours. There is no charge for participation in this program.

- Preference given to members with Junior Staff experience
- Must be energetic, motivated to work with young children
- Must be committed to 1 day of mandatory pre- training
- Must commit to at least 5 weeks of participation in CIT Program
