One-on-One Tutoring - **Lincoln Street** **Ferguson Crestmont** **Ellettsville Club** Volunteers will meet one-on-one with members between 4:15 p.m. - 5:15 p.m. to help with homework and/or reading. The required commitment is 1-2 days per week. LS = 4:15 p.m. - 5:15 pm. / FC = M & Th, 4:00 p.m - 5:00 p.m. / EV = Tu & Th, 3:30 p.m. - 4:30 p.m.

Program Support Volunteer - **Lincoln Street** **Ferguson Crestmont** **Ellettsville Club** Volunteers will develop relationships with members and assist the lead program staff with program implementation. Tasks could include passing out materials, helping with homework, or working with members during special programs (gym, computer lab, STEM activities, etc.). The required commitment is 2 days per week. LS = 5:15 p.m. - 6:00 p.m. / FC & EV = 3:30 p.m. - 5:30 p.m.

Club Riders Bike Volunteer - **Lincoln Street** **Ellettsville Club** Volunteer will join our Club Riders program on bike rides by assisting the Club Riders Coordinator with supervision on rides. Volunteer will also help teach members how to ride a bicycle, bicycle maintenance, vocabulary, and safety. Knowledge of basic bicycle traffic etiquette required (how to signal, how to use lanes, etc.). Mechanical aptitude is a plus! Volunteer does not need to have their own bike but does need to supply their own helmet. The required commitment is 2 days a week. LS = 5:15 p.m. - 6:00 p.m. / EV = 4:30 p.m. - 5:30 p.m.

GRO Skateboarding Volunteer - **Lincoln Street** **Ferguson Crestmont** We are looking for skateboarders who are interested in helping kids learn how to ride. The GRO Skateboarding program has a curriculum to teach safety, equipment, basic skills and etiquette to young riders. Programs are run in the Club, out riding in the community, and at the local skateparks. LS = Tues. & Thurs. from 5:15 p.m. - 5:45 p.m. / FC = Wed. from 4:30 p.m. - 5:30 p.m.

Reading Buddy - **Lincoln Street** Volunteers will meet one-on-one with members to help with reading development and comprehension. Volunteers do not need to have a background in literacy education but it is helpful. Books are provided by the Club. The required commitment is Mon. & Wed. or Tues. & Thurs. from 4:15 p.m. - 5:15 p.m.

Chess Volunteers - **Ferguson Crestmont** Volunteers will assist in the Chess Club programming, which involves up to 1 hour of instruction and 1 hour of free play. Volunteers will either be matched with a member to support active learning of the game or monitor and support games between members. The required commitment is Mon. and Wed. from 4:30 p.m. - 6:30 p.m.

Ukulele or Violin Instructor - **Lincoln Street** Volunteer will meet with a small group of consistent members (5-10 members) to teach ukulele or violin. Volunteer does need to have knowledge of ukulele or violin and youth instruction. Ukuleles and violins are provided by the Club. The required commitment is 2 days a week from 5:15 p.m. - 6:00 p.m.

Dance Instructor - **Ellettsville Club** Assist members during the dance program. The requirement for this position is once a week for 8-10 weeks. The time is flexible, but could be available Monday - Friday from 4:30 p.m. - 5:30 p.m.

Triple Play Field Volunteers - **Ellettsville Club** Volunteers are needed to plan and run an active game with members in our field and playground space. The required commitment is a minimum of two shifts per week, Monday - Friday from 4:30 p.m. - 5:30 p.m.
